

Life Membership

AACUSS members who have retired or moved away from a post-secondary institution in Atlantic Canada and who were outstanding members of the association may be eligible for a Life Membership in AACUSS. Life Membership recognizes the career and/or milestone of retirement of an individual whose impact on their campus or to AACUSS is to be acknowledged and celebrated. Such membership shall be granted to an individual by a vote of the Executive on the recommendation and nomination of a current member of the Association.

Criteria for Consideration

- An application should be submitted by an AACUSS member in good standing, who will nominate the individual.
- Applications should include 1-2 letters of support detailing how the nominee has contributed to and supported AACUSS or their campus over the course of their career.

The nominee must:

- have been a member of AACUSS in the last 5 years
- have had an active membership over the course of their career
- be retiring or moving away from a post-secondary institution in Atlantic Canada between May 1 and April 30 of the current year
- have made a positive contribution to their campus or AACUSS over the course of their career
- be approved by the AACUSS Executive Officers.

Award Details:

Life Members shall be exempt from payment of dues to the Association but shall retain all the rights and privileges of dues-paying members, except for holding office or voting. Life Members are awarded a certificate at the Annual General Meeting.
