

AACUSS Membership Survey

Spring 2011

Executive summary

At the 2010 AACUSS annual general meeting the 2010-2011 AACUSS executive committed to conducting an on line survey to and for the membership in an effort to identify the level of satisfaction with the Association among members as well as to further explore the interest and expectations of the membership toward annual workshops and conferences.

The survey was distributed to the entire AACUSS membership via Survey Monkey from January – April 2011. AACUSS Past President, Tamara Leary, compiled the results and provided a summary to the executive and to the membership at the 2011 AGM.

Survey highlights

- ✓ The on line survey consisted on 10 questions
- ✓ 71 members completed the survey
- ✓ Majority of members are satisfied with supports, services and resources offered by AACUSS
- ✓ Suggestions for continued development included: more communication – skype/Elluminate; additional divisions (academic support) and changes to divisions make-up; consideration about feasibility of Fall workshop
- ✓ Travel costs and session content and divisional meetings are the most significant factors for members to consider attending the conferences/workshops
- ✓ Attending conference/workshops is not a priority for members
- ✓ The bulk of survey participants have not been a member of the executive.
